Application Form

Transcripts

All applicants, regardless of graduation date, are required to submit transcripts from each high school, college, and university attended. If final grades are not available by the application deadline, please submit a preliminary transcript and grades, and arrange for a final transcript to be sent to Bryn Athyn College as soon as it becomes available.

School Report

Current high school students, recent graduates who have been out of high school three years or less, and transfer students must submit the accompanying School Report form (or a copy of it) to your guidance counselor (or career counselor, academic advisor, or similar administrative representative) at your high school, to be completed, signed, and sent by the counselor to Bryn Athyn College.

Test Results

All applicants must arrange for SAT and/or ACT scores to be sent to Bryn Athyn College.

ACT School Code — 3727

All international students must take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) and have your test results

sent to Bryn Athyn College (School Code 2002). Proof of English proficiency can be waived for those students who have spent their entire secondary school education at an English-medium school (where English is the primary language of instruction).
