Bryn Athyn College offers intercollegiate athletics for both women and men in a variety of sports, is a member of the Colonial States Athletic Conference (CSAC), and is an NCAA Division III college.

The Lion's men's teams normally compete in basketball, cross country, golf, ice hockey, lacrosse, and soccer. The women's teams normally compete in basketball, cross country, field hockey, lacrosse, soccer, tennis, and volleyball. Due to COVID, the only teams that competed in 20-21 were the basketball and lacrosse teams.
