

Bryn Athyn College Medical Emergency Action Plan

(Call 911 First in a True Medical Emergency)

Location: General non-specific location action plan

Patient: Student/general campus population

A cell phone should be available for emergency calls.

A responsible "First Aid Responder" should care for the patient until relieved by other medical personnel or Campus Safety.

-EMS should be called for all emergencies listed below

- Blockage or stoppage of Airway, Breathing, or Circulation (ABCs)
- Loss of consciousness
- Seizure (Remove any potentially dangerous objects)
- Severe bleeding, Fracture, dislocation, or deformity
- Head, neck, or spine injury
- Heat illness
- Severe asthma or allergy attack
- Any medical situation you are not trained to care and emergent status is urgent

-When contacting EMS

- State your name
- Give the nature of the injury (including consciousness, mechanism, symptoms)
- Provide the phone number you are calling from and the location of the victim (physical address)
- DO NOT hang up until EMS hangs up first!

-A designated person should meet EMS at the entrance to facility and direct them to the appropriate area.

AED Locations: Cooper-Goodenough common space, Lower Brickman Health Center, Doering Center entrance, Brickman great hall front desk, Junge Pavilion warming room and Asplundh Field House foyer.
