BRING

- Bedding material to fit a standard, twin-sized bed. XL twin fit too
- Pillow
- Laundry Basket and Detergent
- Shower caddy and shower shoes
- Decorations (please see Student Handbook for guidelines NO LED strips allowed)
- School supplies
- Hangers
- Emergency contact information
- Power strips for your electronics
- Cups, plates, and snacks

DON'T BRING

- Cooking Appliances such as hot plates, toaster ovens, or microwaves
- Extension cords
- Inappropriate decorations
- Alcohol, illegal drugs, and weapons
- Irreplaceable Valuables
- LED strips- These damage walls and we don't want you to be fined for damage.

DISCUSS with your roommate

- Personal furnishings*
- Personal refrigerator (not exceeding 5 cubic ft and not exceeding 1.5 amps)
- TV (fire-stick streaming available in lounges)
- Area rug (all rooms are tiled)
- Music/Video Game systems
- Small Fish & Bowl
- Single cup coffee brewers (i.e. Keurig) with automatic shut-off and electric water kettles with automatic shut-off

*The Residence Halls have a bed, nightstand, desk with overhead desk light, chair, dresser, and closet for each resident.

You are welcome to bring smaller items such as lamps, cushions, small coffee tables, bean bag chairs, small bookshelves. You are not allowed to bring larger furniture items such as couches, armchairs, office chairs, or tables. See Student Handbook for more information.
